A perennial Christmas classic film is the theme to this selection as these are all your favourites, wines which you've bought more than any other

White Wines

Bianco di Custoza Italy €10.50 from €12.95
A long-standing favourite, fresh and fruity, with a lovely ability to match food or be drunk on its own. Soft and round but with lovely depth of fruit it's no wonder it's a perennial favourite.

Badajo Spain €11.50 from €13.50
Another stalwart this is fresh and crisp with a zingy style which makes it a great refreshing drink. A very good aperitif wine and also great with fish.

Richter Zeppelin Riesling Germany €13.50 from €15.95
Fabulously versatile, this soft but fresh wine is a great match for shellfish and Thai curries, as well as a super drink-on-its-own wine. Classic riesling at a stunningly good price.

Dom. Thulon Beaujolais Villages France €13.50 from €16.50
A wine that goes with such a wide range of foods due to a rich mid-palate with great weight of soft, ripe fruit. Lovely on its own as well, but a great choice for the holiday season.

Terra de Asorei Albariño Spain €13.50 from €16.95
Classic albariño with soft peachy fruits and fresh apple acidity, great with seafood but also a yummy glass on its own. Refreshing but with a gently fruity side

Red Wines

Sa de Baixo Portugal €11.50 from €14.50
An all-time favourite as its medium-body of spicy, dark-red fruits is a great match for many foods while its supple, rich texture makes it a great drink on its own – more, please!

Duca di Saragnano l'Opera Italy €11.50 from €13.95
Another great favourite as it has a super balance of soft ripe fruits and a rich texture. Four different grapes from all over southern Italy this is a really easy-drinking wine.

Dom. Martin Petit Martin France €11.20 from €13.95
Star of the show this past year and hardly surprising. Blended specially for us this is a soft wine which has great depth. The ideal party wine as it drinks well on its own but also matches hearty foods.

Dom. Martin Côtes du Rhône France €12.50 from €15.75
A long-standing favourite which continues to be popular due to its lovely balance of soft, ripe fruits and medium body. Always a pleasure to drink and a great wine for a wide range of foods.

Dom. Girard Pinot Noir France €15.95 from €19.95
A superb pinot noir from the Pyrenees, with classic cherry and red fruit aromatics, a fresh and lively palate and lovely rich texture. A wine which always over-delivers in terms of quality and style.

Well, Nobody's Perfect...

One of the greatest comedies is the theme film for these unusual wines – not ones you'd see that often. But unlike "Daphne" these are pretty close to perfection!

White Wines

Cocci Grifoni Falerio Italy €12.50 from €15.50
Pecorino – the grape not the cheese – and a super food wine, with those classic fresh zesty fruits and fennel aromatics – have you seen our book of recipes to match?

Gorgi Tondi Zibibbo Italy €13.50 from €16.95
Never heard of zibibbo? Yes, you have, but as muscat! Dry, with lovely floral aromatics, try it with grilled seafood – it's yummy!

La Quercia Montonico Italy €13.50 from €16.95
Never heard of montonico? Neither have we but this is a lovely white wine with a style reminiscent of albariño even though it's from Italy!

Breuer Venture Germany €15.30 from €17.95
A lovely new wine from a well-known estate, this is a yummy appley riesling, with zesty mid-palate and fresh, long finish. Friendly and inviting.

Gorgi Tondi Grillo Italy €15.95 from €19.95
A fresh, fruity white from Sicily this has great weight on the mid-palate making it a yummy wine, especially for seafood.

Red Wines

Clos de Nit Tinto Spain €11.20 from €13.95
A classic north-eastern Spanish blend this wine has rich, slightly spicy fruits allied to a soft and supple palate making it a lovely drink.

Dominio Lote 44 Argentina €11.95 from €14.95
Our first malbec from Argentina this is juicy and fresh, with a rich, soft palate. Drinks well on its own but is great with steaks and red meat.

Gorgi Tondi Nero d'Avola Italy €15.95 from €19.95
Nero d'Avola is one of those little-known lovely grapes – and this is a great example: smooth red cherry fruits, supple but refreshing, a very elegant Sicilian.

Le Formiche Ruché Italy €15.95 from €19.95
If you've never heard of ruché then how about trousseau? Not surprised if you say no to both but what a wonderfully floral and fragrant red, gorgeous!

Ka*Manciné Bergagna Italy €19.20 from €23.95
Another odd Italian red, made from rossese from Dolceacqua, fragrant and floral but with great depth on the palate.

Always Looking For Something...

The movie themed with these wines is a classic western about a man looking..., well, let's say no more. If you are looking for something new to try then these wines are all interesting.

White Wines

Château La Bouyère France €11.50 from €14.50
A classic white Bordeaux but with a twist, there is a very high proportion of sémillon, the classic white grape of Bordeaux. This adds richness and depth to a gorgeous wine.

R Davy Pinot Gris France €12.50 from €15.50
A pinot gris from the Loire? How did we find that? We found it to be yummy, indeed! Lovely soft ripe fruit with a hint of zingy freshness – ideal with shellfish.

Girard Chardonnay France €14.95 from €18.75
Burgundy from the Pyrenees? Yes, indeed – and what a great wine: smooth, elegant, rich, beautifully balanced. One of the best chardonnays we've tried for many a year.

Dom. Thulon Viognier France €14.95 from €18.90
This is going too far – viognier from the Beaujolais? Peachy but with a hint of freshness, quite clean in style, a really interesting variation on a theme.

Court-les-Mûts Annabelle France €15.50 from €18.95
More sémillon, with a wonderfully balanced oak character, this is a stunningly good rich wine, with great food weight, and a lovely complex aromatic style.

Red Wines

Acon Joven Spain €12.35 from €14.50
A very good, rich and drinkable tempranillo from the Ribero del Duero in Spain, this is a wine of real finesse with hints of great power.

Clos de Nit Criança Spain €12.80 from €15.95
The big brother of the wine to the left and much bigger as it's a deeper blend of garnacha, monastrell and syrah but with luscious richness on the mid-palate. Winter warmer!

La Quercia Montepulciano Italy €13.50 from €16.95
A great new wine to our range this is a warm and hearty montepulciano with rich, dark cherry fruit and a supple palate texture.

Paternina Banda Rojo Spain €15.50 from €18.95
Just gorgeous – classic Reserva Rioja with dark, youthful fruits and a smooth, supple medium to full body. A big wine which will age very but is drinking gorgeously right now.

Alana Lumière New Zealand €13.95 from €19.95
This is a real bargain – spicy, cherry pinot noir fruits with a lovely freshness, a really good example of Martinborough character.

Outstanding...

A set of wines which are all-time classics as befitting this film which stands above all others. Here you will find wines of great depth and style which are always in fashion.

White Wines

Le Formiche Gavi di Gavi Italy €15.50 from €19.50
This is such a good wine it's hardly surprising we include year after year. Elegant, fruity with great weight, remarkable style this is a real star.

Cocci Grifoni Offida Pecorino Italy €15.95 from €19.95
A classic example of a little-known grape, pecorino, with super depth, classic white fruits and fennel aromatics and a clean, elegant and long finish. A super dinner wine.

Domaine George Chablis France €15.95 from €19.95
Another long-standing classic, this is fresh, with crisp apple fruits and a lovely texture. Fresh and zesty enough as an aperitif but weighty enough to match any Christmas turkey and ham!

Doudeau Leger Sancerre France €15.95 from €19.95
Again a classic of many years' standing, this is a super example of sauvignon blanc – fresh and zippy, but with lovely weight and body. Great with food but smashing on its own as well.

Dureuil-Janthial Rully Blanc France €27.20 from €33.95
For us, one of the best producers in Burgundy, making wines of both elegance and power. This is a yummy white with rich, ripe cox's pippin fruit notes and deep palate. Mmmmm!

Red Wines

Clos de Gamot France €18.20 from €22.75
Malbec from its spiritual home, this red (a mere 9 years old!) has tremendous depth and roundness. Powerful and elegant at the same time, a great treat and wonderful with goose, for them that do!

Dom. Martin Rasteau Sommets France €19.20 from €23.95
From the southern Rhône, this is a big wine with a soft heart. Rich, dark bramble fruits and a full-body make it a real winter warmer, but its elegance and finesse also make it a wine to savour.

Piazzo Barolo Italy €22.50 from €27.95
Classic nebbiolo from its home, this is a remarkably smooth and elegant wine. Lovely ripe cherry notes and moderate tannins make it a great wine for food..

Dureuil-Janthial Rully Rouge France €27.20 from €33.95
Superb red with classy and classic pinot noir style – dark red fruits, a savoury edge, lovely depth and elegance and a long finish. Fabulous way to finish Christmas dinner!

Ch. La Fleur des Ormes France €27.95 from €34.95
A lovely Pomerol with the classic soft richness from merlot and a great dinner wine. Savoury and ripe, with fine-grained tannins this is a real classic
